COVID-19 INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN

SCENARIO #1: FACE-TO-FACE

Students meet in person for instruction, at school, using guidance from the CDC, DESE, MO School Board Association, and Am. Academy of Pediatrics.

Trained and certified TGCA teachers adjust learning to acclimate students to the school setting, tailor curriculum to the needs of the students, and offer extra opportunities for individualized instruction.

Implement health practices, such as: frequent hand washing, disinfecting surfaces, appropriate social distancing, required health screenings, protective equipment (face masks), and limiting capacity based on current health advisories.

Students will be prepared to adjust to virtual learning quickly, if necessary.

SCENARIO #2: HYBRID MODEL

Students meet on a modified schedule using a combination of face-to-face instruction and virtual learning.

Trained and certified TGCA teachers adjust learning to acclimate students to the school setting, tailor curriculum to the needs of the students, and offer extra opportunities for individualized instruction.

Implement health practices, such as: frequent hand washing, disinfecting surfaces, appropriate social distancing, required health screenings, protective equipment (face masks), and limiting capacity based on current health advisories.

Students will be prepared to adjust to virtual learning quickly, if necessary.

SCENARIO #3: ALL VIRTUAL

Students participate in a carefully designed virtual learning program at home.

Trained and certified TGCA teachers adjust learning to acclimate students to the school setting, tailor curriculum to the needs of the students, and offer extra opportunities for individualized instruction. Focus will be on key concepts.

Virtual learning program will include courses provided by online vendors, such as Abeka or Bob Jones University, in addition to Zoom or Google Classroom lessons with TGCA trained and certified teachers.

Participation and attendance will be required in order to ensure continued learning and preparation for the next grade level.

As we develop plans that consider various aspects of how our school might be affected, we must be flexible. These plans may be scaled up or down depending on local conditions. No matter which scenario, our mission is to provide a complete education which promotes academic excellence and a biblical worldview. It is the goal of Tower Grove Christian Academy to equip students with the intellect and character they need to impact their world.
